Habitat for Humanity ReStores are retail outlets where quality used and surplus building material and home items are sold at a fraction of normal prices. Proceeds from ReStores help local Habitat for Humanity affiliates fund the construction of homes within the community. Many affiliates across the United States and Canada operate successful ReStores—some of which raise enough funds to build an additional 10 or more house per year!

Materials sold by Habitat ReStores are usually donated by building supply stores, contractors, demolition crews or from individuals who wish to show their support for Habitat. In addition to raising funds, ReStores help the environment by rechanneling good, usable materials into use.
