Women Build Crew Leader Training Plan

Crew leaders are responsible for leading groups of approximately 5 volunteers on the construction site. They are knowledgeable in the specific area they are teaching and have an understanding of site safety, use of tools, and Habitat's mission.

Construction tasks in which crew leaders may become trained include block masonry, framing walls, shaft walls, joists, decking, insulation, drywall, windows, exterior and interior doors, trim, paint, vinyl flooring, and kitchen cabinets. Crew leaders report to the Construction Director.

1. Attend a full cycle of (4) Basic Training Clinics at Lowe's
2. Participate in building on the Habitat construction site for a minimum of 10 days

The current Habitat Bucks construction site is the Emerald Hollow development in Milford Township. Volunteers work most Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. All work days must be scheduled in advance through the Volunteer Associate. Volunteers arrive at 8:30am and work until 4:00pm.

3. Co-lead a volunteer group with a Habitat staff member
4. Attend Crew Leader Build Day and Leadership Training Seminar on Saturday, May 17th, 2008 at Emerald Hollow.
