Requires the physical ability to sit, walk, and/or stand for prolonged periods of time. This individual must also have the use of all senses, to include, but not limited to sight, hearing, smell and taste while possessing the ability to stand, stoop, bend, grasp and/or hold to complete construction duties, adhered to safety standards, drive, and perform all duties at the worksite without accommodations. The normal work place will be construction worksites and indoor home repairs. This position requires the ability to withstand varying temperatures including outdoor climates. This position requires individuals who are able to safely lift at least 50 lbs. frequently and up to 100 pounds occasionally.
