

MEETING THE CHALLENGE: LONG TERM AFFORDABILITY

HABITAT'S NEW LAND TRUST MODEL

Many people are priced out of the current housing market in Bucks County, including nursing assistants, EMT's, daycare and hospital workers, warehouse and restaurant employees. The lack of affordable housing in our county continues to be a major issue, and contributes to a local shortage of essential workers.

With the escalating costs of housing, Habitat is frequently the only option for the working families of our County to achieve homeownership. These same high costs, specifically the astronomical cost of real estate, have also limited Habitat's ability to serve these families......families that already rent and work in our County, who want to remain here.

Due to the recent rise in home prices, and near tripled interest rates, many prospective home buyers can't afford a decent home, and in many cases no longer qualify for the mortgage they would need.

The beauty of our new land trust model is that Habitat's affordable homes will be attainable not just to the first homebuyer, but to all subsequent buyers. We are creating long-lasting affordability for generations of households in Bucks County.

So how does it work? What is different? Through the land trust, Habitat Bucks retains ownership of the land, while our buyers purchase their houses with affordable mortgages. Just as before, they own their homes – continuing the tradition of putting down roots, growing, dreaming and thriving.

Our homeowners pay taxes on the full value of both the land and the house, so that the communities in which they live will remain fully funded for everyone's benefit. And, the land trust model incentivizes continued home maintenance and improvements.

When our homeowners choose to move on – they agree to resell their home to another qualified homebuyer at an affordable price, earning a share of the increase in the value of their home. This way, our homeowners get to "pay it forward" to the next generation of Habitat homebuyers!

"Thank you so much for helping my family with our bathroom. We weren't sure how we were going to get this done. Thanks to you we can now access our bathroom freely."




Paying it Forward
